- In the year 1979, the first woman to win in the Nobel Peace Prize was **Mother Terasa**. She was the first woman to give her whole life to social work.
- **Indira Gandhi** was the first woman Prime Minister of India from the year 1966 to 1997. She was named as the “Woman of the Millennium” in a poll that was organized by BBC in 1999. She first woman to receive the Bharat Ratna award.
- In the year 1972, **KiranBedi** became the first woman officer in India for joining the Indian Police Service. Moreover she was the woman who was appointed as the United Nations Civil Police adviser.
- **PrathibhaPatil** was the first woman President of India from July 2007 to July 2012.
- The only women boxer who medal in every six World Championships is **MangteChungneijang**
Mary Komis also known as Mary Kom. She was the only Indian women boxer to win a gold medal in Asian Games in the year 2014.
- Kalpanachawla was the first Indian women to reach the space in the year 1997 as mission specialist and a primary robotic arm operator.

According to the statistics only 22 women out of 997 athletes competed in the modern Olympics in the year 1990.

OFFENCES AGAINST WOMEN AND CHILDREN UNDER THE INDIAN PENAL CODE

The Indian Penal Code, 1860 has given some of the provisions to penalize the victim for the offences against women. Some of the specific sections are given below under IPC:

- Section 326A and section 326B lays down acid attack and the punishment for acid attacks.
- Section 375, 376A, 376B, 376C, 376E explains about rape and punishments for rape.
- Section 376 and 511 for attempt to commit rape.
- Section 302, 304B, and 306 for Murder, Dowry death, Abetment of Suicide etc.
- Section 354A for Sexual harassment.
- Section 354C for Voyeurism.
- Section 345D for Stalking.
